

The THEBA Brokerage Program is money dedicated from THEBA's recurrent funding received from the Department of Community Services, under the Supported Accommodation Assistance Program.

The program is a resource for Women accessing our agency to gain services intended to improve their health, well-being and independent living skills.

Eligibility

The brokerage program can be accessed by Women 18-25 who are participants of the THEBA Independent Living Skills program and clients accessing the THEBA Exit and Outreach programs. Casual clients of THEBA are invited to apply.

BROKERAGE may be approved for services including:

- Provide assistance for fees towards health and well being services including dental, osteopathic, chiropractic, naturopathic treatments
- Initial set up costs for moving into independent living programs
- Assistance in exiting THEBA to independent housing
- Therapeutic and counselling fees
- Self improvement courses
- Attending activities which add to living skills, life skills or your current goals and life direction
- Training and education costs
- Uniform or clothing requirements for work or related training needs



Brokerage may be provided for either the full amount of anticipated costs or in partnership with clients making a Contribution.

Where complimentary services are provided at appropriate community based not for profit services, your brokerage request may be directed to existing community services providing services to women on limited incomes.

Brokerage may be approved for services on a limited time frame.

If there is a request which is identified by staff as a need for financial assistance, THEBA will direct you to agencies providing such services such as St Vincent DePaul or Salvation Army.

How to apply for the brokerage program at THEBA

Requests can be discussed with the Housing Resource Worker or the Manager and you can obtain an application, complete and return it.

Process of decision

Your request will be discussed at the next team meeting and we will advise you of the outcome. Decisions depend on the availability of brokerage funds available.

Decisions are based on the eligibility criteria, the aims and objectives of the brokerage program and whether the request for funds supports the development of skills and well-being towards living independently.

Priority is given to clients accessing the THEBA Programs. Where funds permit THEBA may approve applications from Women who access THEBA on a casual, informal basis.
